Case No. 19-3968: Calvert Hospice has applied for a variance in the side setback requirement from 30' to 1' and a variance in the front setback requirement from 60' to 1' as measured from the State Highway Administration's 15-foot widening strip adjacent to Sixes Road, for the purpose of constructing a new entrance sign to the Calvert-Burnett Hospice House. The subject property is located at 4559 Sixes Road, Prince Frederick (Tax Map 27, Parcel 418, Lot 1) and is zoned Farm and Forest District (FFD). [APPLICATION](#)

Case No. 19-3969: Charles Fragman has applied for a variance in the front setback requirement adjacent to Mills Creek Drive from 25' to 5' for construction of a 24' x 24' pole barn.
