



Breezy Point Daily Campground Rules

NO PETS ALLOWED. Only Registered Service Animals are permitted in the park.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations must be made at least 72 hours in advance of the reservation start date in order to receive a refund, minus a \$5 cancellation fee. Refunds will not be made for "No Shows", inclement weather, or early departures.

KEY DEPOSIT: \$20.00 (CASH) key deposit fee is collected at Check-In. The key is required to exit and enter the Park after closing. The key deposit fee will be refunded at Check-Out upon the return of key and campsite cleared of all property and trash.

Camping units allowed per campsite: One (1) RV; One (1) RV and one (1) tent; or two (2) tents. Screened tents and shade canopies are excluded if not used for sleeping. Overnight sleeping on the beach between the campsite fence and water is not permitted.

There is a limit of 6 people per campsite.

Vehicle Parking: Each campsite is **limited to 2 vehicles**. One (1) vehicle is permitted to park on the site and one (1) vehicle in the public parking area. NO parking in the roadways. Violators will be towed at owner's expense and a \$25.00 fee will be charged.

The maximum allowed reservation is 14 days; campers must vacate the park for a minimum of 5 days prior to the next reservation.

CHECK-IN: 4:00 - 7:00 PM. Campers must check in by 7:00 PM or risk forfeiting their reservation. You may call in advance if you know you will arrive late to retain your reservation. Arriving after 7:00 PM may forfeit your first night's stay and require set up site the next day after 8:00 AM. Absolutely NO refunds will be made for forfeited night. Any camper arriving before 4 PM check in time will be charged an additional General Admission fee at the Park gate.

CHECK-OUT: No later than 1:00 PM. Checking out after 1:00 PM will result in an additional day charge.

- Quiet hours: 11:00 PM - 7:00 AM
- No utility trailers, boats, golf carts, or scooters are allowed in the Park.
- No lifeguards on duty. Swim at your own risk. Swimming is permitted in designated areas only.
- No amplified music is allowed in beach, picnic, or campground areas.
- Alcohol is permitted. No glass containers.
- Underage drinking, use of illegal drugs, or excessive use of alcoholic beverages will result in immediate removal by local authorities.
- All guests must pay the Park General Admission fees. All guests must leave the Park at closing time.
- Campers are responsible for the behavior of their children and guests at all times.
- A responsible adult must accompany and actively supervise children under the age of 18.
- Keep off wooden or stone groin structures. Do not remove stones from the stone groins.
- Fishing and crabbing is permitted in designated areas with appropriate license.
- The following are prohibited: firearms; fireworks of any kind; driving on the beach; inappropriate language and/or abusive profanity; inappropriate behavior, drunkenness, disorderly conduct, indecent exposure; any act committed in violation of the law. Violations will result in immediate ejection from the Park. No refunds will be given.
- Campers are responsible for removing their trash from the campsite. Trash must be placed in plastic bags and deposited in the property's dumpsters. Please recycle as much as possible in the provided bins.
- Report any damages of property or campsite to the Park office. Campers are encouraged to contact local authorities for personal property damages.
- All persons and property must be able to evacuate the Park within 24 hours of notice of evacuation due to hurricane, severe storms or storm surge. No refunds will be given for time lost due to evacuations.

Breezy Point Beach and Campground reserves the right to terminate the privileges granted at any time, immediately and without refund from disorder, intoxication, or noncompliance with any of the Park rules and regulations and the provisions of this agreement.
