A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO APPROVAL OF BUDGET ADJUSTMENT #BA180

WHEREAS, Title 5 of the <u>Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County</u>, <u>Maryland</u>, being Title 5 of <u>Article 5</u> of the <u>Code of Public Laws of Maryland</u> (hereinafter, the "<u>Code</u>"), authorizes and empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland (hereinafter, the "Board of County Commissioners") to adopt the Annual Budget and Appropriation Act each year;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, has the authority pursuant to Section 5-103 of the <u>Code</u> to enact certain budgetary adjustments by Resolution;

WHEREAS, the County collects a grant from the Program Open Space Land Acquisition Fund, along with additional funding that will be reallocated from the County Administration Building Project, with the intent of providing for the purchase of several parcels of property on Fairground Road in Prince Frederick, MD for a potential site of a Recreational Facility;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Finance and Budget that the Program Open Space Land Acquisition fund has \$500,000 available for use in land acquisition for recreational purposes;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Finance and Budget that the County Administration Building Project budget of \$3,500,000, of which \$1,300,000 will not be needed in Fiscal 2018 due to project phasing;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Finance and Budget that it desires to use these funds to purchase several parcels of land to complete a community center/recreational facility in the Price Frederick Town Center as has been discussed since the adoption of the 1997 comprehensive plan. The BOCC entered into an option agreement with the owners of several parcels of property on July 25th, 2017: 110 Fairground Road, Prince Frederick, MD, 20678; 30 Fairground RD, Prince Frederick MD, 20678; 76 Rawlings Road, Prince Frederick MD 20678; 72 Rawlings Road, Prince Frederick, MD 20678 (collectively, the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to increase the capital budget to ensure there are funds available to complete the acquisition of the Property;

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding this Budget Adjustment #BA180 was duly advertised in two County newspapers for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing as required by Section 5-103(c) of the <u>Code</u> and held on October 31st 2017, at which time the Board of County Commissioners received public comment; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the comments of the public and staff and in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County, Maryland to adopt Budget Adjustment #BA180 as set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, hereby approves and enacts the appropriations and expenditures set forth in Budget Adjustment #BA180 in the amount of \$1,800,000 a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, to amend

and append financial resources to the FY2018 capital budget as set forth in Exhibit "A" to complete the property acquisition.

- **BE** IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the Calvert County Capital Improvement Program for FY2018, as amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, that, in the event any portion of this Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, null or void, by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to sever only the invalid portion or provision, and that the remainder of the Resolution shall be enforceable and valid, unless deletion of the invalid portion would defeat the clear purpose of the Resolution, or unless deletion of the valid portion would produce a result inconsistent with the purpose and intent of the Board of County Commissioners in enacting this Resolution.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED,** by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED,** by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation and publication of a fair summary.
