The standards address disqualification from participation, prohibited secondary employment, prohibited ownership interests, misuse of position, prohibited solicitation and acceptance of gifts, misuse of confidential information, post-employment limitations, prohibited dealings with the County, and procurement specifications assistance restrictions. The Ordinance provides for exceptions and exemptions under certain circumstances.

#### PRIVACY NOTICE

The County Ethics Ordinance requires the collection of this information, which will be used primarily for public disclosure and to determine compliance with the Ordinance. The information may be disclosed to any requesting person, including officials of State, local or federal government, who records their name and address and this record will be provided to the filer upon request. The subject has the right to amend, review and correct the record as set forth in the County Ethics Ordinance. **Failure to file or to report information required by the County Ethics Ordinance can result in penalties including a late filing fee up to \$250, suspension, suspension of pay, termination or other disciplinary action, and a civil fine of up to \$2,500 per violation.
