FEES

ADR accepts most major health insurance to cover your fees. Our staff will verify your benefits for you and pre-authorize your care. Our staff will inform you of your benefits before your first appointment. **Even if you do not use your insurance, our cash fees are less than any other program.**

DUI/DWI Education

If you are assessed as requiring alcohol and drug education, you will be required to complete a 12-hour, 6-week educational program. At ADR, you may use your health insurance to cover this cost.

Clients may also use cash or credit card to pay for the 6-week education program.

Our rates are totally inclusive. Other programs may charge a lower group rate but then add an additional charge for urinalysis, so your cost at "discount programs" is actually higher.

Treatment

Individuals with a more extensive substance abuse history may require longer treatment. ADR will accept most health insurance for treatment and we can also offer a sliding scale for persons on a limited income.
